Enrollment Begins in January

On January 3, we will begin accepting applications for kindergartners and for new students in preschool through grade eight for the 2012-13 school year. This includes new students from current families. Students in kindergarten through grade seven will receive re-enrollment packets mid-February.

Because the kindergarten classes have filled up rapidly in the past, the date of application can be very important. We will be offering a full-day kindergarten and a half-day kindergarten program. Please remember to make your preference when applying. The half-day program is 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. or 12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m., and the full-day program is 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.
